



# MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

**Regular Meeting: July 23, 2026**

## **Operations:**

- We responded to 78 calls in June.
- Today we are 108 calls ahead of last year.
- Average response time in May was 10 minutes and 31 seconds.
- Weekend of July 11<sup>th</sup> we responded via mutual aid to small wildland fires in Nederland, Black Hawk, and Golden Gate.

## **Support Services:**

- The new Smokey Wildfire sign was installed at Station 3. Still have them for 1,2,5 and 7.
- MIT 1 a total loss and we have received payment from insurance for \$50,000 – they did not remove a deductible.
- All of our SCBA air packs and bottles have been serviced for the year
- Working to chase down a wiring issue on one of the engines

## **Wildland/Mitigation:**

- Brush 59 returned today from a short 5-day deployment in Steamboat and will be available shortly. We have one firefighter deployed to California on a Nederland truck.
- Lots of free firewood available at Station 4.

## **Administration:**

- Blake Dawson just announced that he has accepted a new position and his last day will be August 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Emily Cresswell will be promoted to the full-time position.
- Still working with USDA and KCI to complete billing and paperwork
- County Fair was a success, the community seems very supportive of Timberline.

## **R&R:**

- We are onboarding 2 new shift volunteers out of our normal cycle

## **Training Events and Activities:**

- We will be doing lots of training in the old food pantry over the next two weeks, prior to it being torn down.
