



MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: April 15, 2026

Operations:

- We responded to 110 calls in March. We are approximately 60 calls ahead of last year.
- Average response time in March was 9 minutes and 14 seconds.
- All TFPD apparatus are out of Station 4, and Tender is now responding from Station 3.

Support Services:

- Engine 55 repairs and service are complete
- Engine 59 service and minor repairs are complete
- Dishwasher at Station 7 replaced
- Minor repairs to B59 and the foam system installed

Wildland/Mitigation:

- Brush 59 is available nationally.
- We are swamped with assessment and residential work.
- The new Porter Ranch clean-up phase was completed.
- Pinecliffe mitigation is ongoing
- Looking at software specific to billing and managing the ever-expanding mitigation program.
- We still have \$110,874 outstanding for the 2025 deployment season.
- We completed a full 14-day deployment that started in South Dakota at the Qury Fire, then to Fort Collins, and finished in northern Wyoming as part of a task force assisting the Kane Fire.
- Lots of free firewood is available to the community at Station 4.

Administration:

- Multiple construction meetings
- USDA meetings
- Applied for wildland PPE through the VFA grant, should hear next month.

R&R:

- We have 12 new recruits who have completed onboarding!!

Training Events and Activities:

- This month's training is the burn building in Clear Creek on Saturday, approximately 30 members will be attending.
