



MONTHLY FIRE CHIEFS REPORT

Regular Meeting: March 10, 2026

Operations:

- We responded to 37 calls in February.
- On Feb 26th we assisted Golden Gate on a structure fire. We sent two tenders, one engine, and a brush truck for over 6 hours.
- On Feb 27th, we assisted again with an engine and tender for an additional 6 hours.
- I am working on generating reports from our new system.
- Capt. Femmer has been updating our radios for Boulder's new toning channel

Support Services:

- We are finalizing our order for 7 sets of bunker gear.
- E55 is in our shop for several items.
- U53 is in the body shop for warranty body work.
- Minor warranty work on B56.
- Handled several small items at Stn 3 to help control cost

Wildland/Mitigation:

- Brush 59 is available nationally.
- Residential work is still ongoing.
- We have begun the Pinecliffe Mitigation project
- We have another phase of Porter Ranch work that will take about 2 weeks
- We hired 4 new MIT people and added a volunteer to the crew. We have 15 part-time MIT workers, each working 0-30 hours per week.
- We still have \$160,000 outstanding for the 2025 deployment season.

Administration:

- Multiple construction meetings
- USDA meetings
- First Due implementation
- We received about a \$7,000 refund from insurance because they failed to cancel a policy a year and a half ago.
- We received our grant funds from Boulder County Grants.

R&R:

- Completed new hire volunteer interviews
- We have 12 new recruits in onboarding.

Training Events and Activities:

- This month's training is the Annual wildfire refresher. Line construction, pump and roll, hand tool deployment, and structure protection.
